

ASSETS

RBYC's buildings, equipment and on-water assets experience continual use, and require ongoing maintenance. This is scheduled by club staff and undertaken by staff, contractors and volunteers.

Maintenance over the past six months has included;

- Replacement of wheelbarrows
- Repainting of white lines in the carparks
- Hardstand cleanup and removal of barnacles on piles
- Replacement of fire hydrants on marina.
- Repair and replacement of RBYC fixed marks
- Repair of rhib tubes
- Replacement of rhib steering systems. (Club rhibs will have engines replaced next year under the leasing program).
- Replacement console for key rhib
- Installation of new wind instruments on hardstand (for Davis Instruments readings)
- Ongoing repairs and maintenance on 12 Optis, 11 Quests and 2 Lasers used for training and racing squads
- The club keelboat has a replacement mast
- Repairs to sauna and steam room seats

A QR code system and App has been launched to enable members to report problems they see while using the Club facilities, with a view to improving maintenance around the club.
