# COMMODORE'S REPORT

It is with great pride that I present the Commodore's Report for the 2025/26 season.

First and foremost, I extend my sincere thanks to the General Committee, Sub Committees, volunteers, donors, our General Manager and all staff for their dedication and support throughout the year.

## Financial Overview

In last year's Annual Report, the Past Treasurer noted that our Club had faced a few difficult years as it absorbed several structural changes to our cost base. The FY26 financial result should be viewed as an important inflection point in the evolution of our finances. Softer trading conditions, a decline in marina revenue, rising employment, insurance and occupancy costs, together with significant one off expenditure exceeding \$200,000 on attenuator repairs, have placed increasing pressure on operating performance.

Hospitality operations remain a concern. Despite an improvement in café revenue and cost of goods sold, a decline in functions and member services revenue, together with continued high labour costs, contributed to another large loss in hospitality operations. This is of considerable concern to the General Committee and management, who commissioned a report into the options for the hospitality business.

Our financial position remains supported by relatively low levels of debt, healthy liquidity and valuable marina assets, although underlying trading performance remains a concern. This year's stronger cash position was driven largely by disciplined working capital management rather than improved trading performance and should not be regarded as a substitute for sustainable operating surpluses.

While management has worked to contain wage growth and manage costs, recurring revenues are no longer increasing at the same rate as the cost of delivering the high standard of sailing, hospitality and other member services expected

by members. As a result, we have less capacity to absorb unexpected costs and reduced flexibility to fund future investment.

The 2025/26 result suggests that our Club has reached a point where business as usual may no longer be sufficient. It also provides an opportunity to consider how we can continue to evolve in response to changing economic conditions and member expectations.

## On the Water

The past season proved an exceptionally challenging year for our fleets. The first half of the season brought strong winds and big seas, with many events abandoned or disrupted. Nevertheless, after Christmas, Port Phillip returned to the





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outstanding sailing conditions for which it is renowned, allowing our fleets sailing on weekends and midweek to enjoy a strong finish to the season.

Our Club continues to offer a wide range of sailing options for members, including Wednesday afternoon and twilight sailing, a full weekend program for keelboats, one design, off the beach yachts and cruising activities. In response to members' requests, we introduced Sunday keelboat sailing. The response has been encouraging and hopefully will see more yachts out as the weather improves.

This year's Presentation Night was a wonderful celebration of the breadth and depth of sailing, with many members recognised for their achievements and contributions throughout the season. We should also take particular pride in the outstanding performances of RBYC boats and crews at major regattas, both close to home and further afield, from

the 2025 Whitsundays Regattas, Cock of the Bay, Stonehaven Cup and Festival of Sails, to the Australian ILCA Masters Championships at Port Stephens and, more recently, the European Etchells Championships.

Alongside our busy sailing program, we continued to demonstrate our capacity to host major events and high performance sailing. We welcomed Sail Melbourne and the Australian Sailing Team in November and December, hosted the Victorian Optimist State Titles in March and, more recently, the King's Cup for the Optimist fleet. The year ahead promises to be equally busy, with Sail Melbourne and the Australian Sailing Team returning later in the year, followed by the Optimist Nationals and the 2.4mR Nationals in January 2027.

Our commitment to developing women's sailing has also continued to grow through the Bliss Regatta, our support for the Port Phillip Women's Championship, the KISS program and





the Australian Women's Keelboat Regatta. These initiatives have introduced many women to sailing, with a number subsequently joining RBYC and becoming regular and valued crew in our keelboat fleet. This is an important contribution to building the future of sailing at our Club.

Our strong partnerships with Australian Sailing, the Ocean Racing Club of Victoria and the Victorian International Optimist Dinghy Association continue to play an important role in building the future of sailing at RBYC. Through these relationships, we can host major events, support sailor development, attract new participants and strengthen pathways from introductory programs through to state, national and international competition. These partnerships not only benefit our members but also reinforce RBYC's role in strengthening sailing across Victoria and Australia.

Together, these achievements reflect the strength, commitment and depth of sailing within our Club, and the calibre of our sailors who continue to represent our Club with distinction on the national and international stage.

## **Around the Club**

The success of a yacht club should be measured by more than its financial outcomes. At its heart, our Club provides a warm and welcoming environment where members can meet, participate and simply enjoy being "at their Club". This year's social activities have contributed significantly to the vibrancy of RBYC, from memorable events associated with the Friday Night Draws, other functions, regular pool table competitions and Cruising Group dinners covering an entertaining and diverse range of topics. My thanks to the Social Subcommittee and the many members who have contributed their time and enthusiasm throughout the year.

Our Aquatic members and the Icebergers continue to be one of our Club's most vibrant and welcoming communities, with membership steadily growing and women now making up an equal share of the group. Beyond the obvious challenge of swimming daily through winter, the Icebergers provide a

strong sense of friendship, wellbeing and belonging. Events such as the Winter Solstice and Olsen Hooper swims, together with regular social gatherings, have helped build a community that extends well beyond the water. It is particularly pleasing to see the growing participation of women, reflecting the inclusive and welcoming nature of the group.

As 2025 and our 150th Celebrations ended, a book was launched celebrating 150 years of sailing at RBYC. We are deeply grateful to Don Warner and John Scanlon for bringing our history to life, with Don researching archives and interviewing members and John curating photographs and designing the book. We also thank Past Commodore Niesje Hees for her invaluable contribution. Together, they have created a wonderful and lasting tribute to RBYC's rich history.

Membership growth has plateaued, with numbers slightly below the peak of 1,801 last year. Most membership categories were either unchanged or lost a few members, while the number of youth and intermediate members increased slightly. Over the past decade, membership has grown by almost 20 percent.

RBYC continues to be active in the community. During the year, we supported The Great Bayside Swim, while our annual Oaks Day Lunch raised almost \$14,000 for Sailing Lifts Your Spirits, a RBYC based charity introducing healthcare and emergency service workers to the joy of sailing. The inaugural RBYC Car Show raised money for the Cancer Council and looks likely to be even bigger in the coming year. Continued collaboration with Rotary and local schools further strengthened our community connections.

We continue to play an important role in ensuring the sustainability of the marina environment. RBYC retains its Level 3 Cleaner Marina accreditation from the Marina Industries Association, placing it among just ten Victorian clubs to hold this status. Single use plastic bottles have been eliminated from hospitality venues, while clearly marked recycling bins promote participation in the Victorian Container Deposit



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Scheme. A partnership with North Brighton Sea Scouts ensures proceeds from recycling support youth development. Since its installation in 2021, our solar system has generated nearly 483 MWh of clean energy, reducing emissions by 290,000 kg, the equivalent of planting 5,650 trees.

### Facilities and Development

Our Club has secured a new 21-year seabed lease. Negotiations, led by our GM, Past Commodores Niesje Hees and Past Commodore Peter Strain and our Honorary Treasurer, resulted in a new lease being signed in February this year. On behalf of members, I would like to thank everyone involved for their efforts. I would also like to acknowledge the assistance of Steve Walker, CEO of the Boating Industry Association of Victoria, and James Newbury, the Member for Brighton in the Victorian Parliament, for their support in assisting our application.

The financing and replacement of the attenuator remain a priority and preliminary investigations have commenced on the options available to us. We have continued with maintenance of the attenuator, and a decision was made to appoint a qualified contractor to sleeve five piles while we organised the replacement bearings.

The RBYC Future Development Fund, supported by member donations and bequests, is progressing a new Master Plan. Our previous Master Plan successfully guided development for 20 years, but with lease renewal discussions with Council commencing within the next seven years, it is time to create a new vision for RBYC. On behalf of the Working Group, I thank members and sponsors who contributed to the first round of seed funding. We have raised \$50,000 but need a further \$50,000 to commence the initial concept and preliminary site analysis. Donations to the RBYC Development Fund through the Australian Sports Foundation are tax deductible and held separately for the Master Plan project.

### Looking Ahead

Your new General Committee, led by the incoming Commodore, faces considerable challenges and deserves your full support. Our Club is experiencing economic headwinds, including low levels of consumer confidence and inflation. This will impact our operating costs and revenue and may also affect people's commitment to boat ownership. Going back to business as usual is no longer an option and a different approach is required. This has underpinned the review of our hospitality operations, while discussions are underway with Australian Sailing to improve the delivery of off the beach sailing not only at our Club but in Victoria and beyond.

In closing, I thank all members for your ongoing support over the past two years.

Wishing you fair winds and following seas, and remember, no bananas at sea.

#### Training

The Club offers sailing instruction for children, young people and adults, together with powerboat courses and training for race management volunteers. Members also benefit from the considerable knowledge and practical advice generously shared throughout the Club community.

#### Other Racing

RBYC members compete in events organised by, or in partnership with, other clubs. The Club also provides race management support for many Ocean Racing Club of Victoria events and for series conducted jointly with other major clubs at the northern end of Port Phillip Bay, including the Range Series.

#### Regattas

RBYC continues to serve as the Organising Authority for numerous class regattas. During 2025–26, the Club again hosted Sail Melbourne, as well as state and national championships for several fleets. The coming season will be equally active, with Sail Melbourne, the Optimist National Championships, the 2.4mR National Championships and the ILCA Masters among the major events scheduled.

#### Women in Sailing

RBYC has a longstanding commitment to increasing women's participation in sailing. The Club participates in the Port Phillip Women's Championship Series and conducts its signature Brighton Ladies' Skipper Series (BLISS). Subsidized coaching sessions are offered aboard the Club keelboat. RBYC members continue to contribute to the Ocean Racing Club of Victoria's Keelboat Introduction to Sailing Savvy (KISS) program. This year, the Club is also offering subsidised diesel engine courses specifically for women. The club has also started a Monthly Sunday Keelboat race which has a Female Skippers division and is open to both RBYC and Non RBYC boats.

#### Junior and Youth Sailing

As an accredited Australian Sailing Discover Sailing Centre, RBYC offers instruction in Optimist dinghies for children from six years of age through to their early teens. Programs are conducted on Sundays and during school holidays, and are regularly fully booked.

Club-owned Quest dinghies provide teenagers with the opportunity to learn in a three-person crew, while further pathways are available through the ILCA fleet and in 29ers and 420s. The Club looks forward to strengthening and expanding these programs in the year ahead.



RBYC is often a base for VIODA training. Camps are held over the year.

### **Other Sailing Activities**

Members cruise throughout Port Phillip Bay and venture as far afield as south-west Tasmania and the Pacific. The Cruising Group hosts monthly dinners featuring guest speakers, which are open to all Club members and their guests.

Members also support Sailing Lifts Your Spirits, an initiative that provides healthcare workers with opportunities to sail aboard members' keelboats.

### **Race Management Volunteers**

Regular club racing and major regattas place significant demands on the Sailing Office and volunteers. Many RBYC members generously contribute their time, skills and experience. Their teamwork is both rewarding and essential to the Club's success and vitality.

### **Thursday Working Group**

A sincere thankyou is extended to the dedicated and highly skilled members of the Thursday Working Group. Their contribution to the maintenance and improvement of the Club's facilities is substantial and greatly appreciated.

### **Sailing Committee and Sailing Office**

My sincere thanks to Boating Manager Colin Burgess and his team for their capable leadership and effective management of the sailing program.

## MARINA AND ATTENUATOR ADVISORY PANEL

A key priority for RBYC is replacement of the wave attenuator. The attenuator at RBYC was installed to protect the new floating Marina approximately 25 years ago. As part of our ongoing asset management program, we are exploring replacement alternatives for the future.

A Water, Coastal and Environmental Consulting firm was engaged to advise on solutions for an attenuator replacement as well as short term maintenance recommendations.

The consultants assessed three options for the attenuator replacement; extension of the rock breakwater, a fixed wave wall, and a replacement floating attenuator. Each of these has advantages and disadvantages in terms of cost, complexity of installation and ongoing maintenance overheads (lifecycle cost).

As part of the maintenance program, a contractor was appointed to sleeve 5 piles. New and larger piles were driven into the seabed over the old piles and the gap filled with epoxy grout.

Replacement of the Attenuator remains a priority, and the Advisory Panel will soon recommence further review of the various options as well as funding.

The dredging of the marina has been paused pending finalisation of the entire capital works program, including completion of the short-term maintenance required.

Now that RBYC has a new 21-year lease in place, the club is in a much better position to plan for the replacement. Parks Victoria has been engaged to understand their perspective and to keep them informed.

**R**BYC's buildings, equipment and on-water assets experience continual use, and require ongoing maintenance. This is scheduled by club staff and undertaken by staff, contractors and volunteers, including the regular group of Thursday volunteers.

A QR code system and App has been launched to enable members to report problems they see while using the Club facilities, with a view to improving maintenance around the club.

## Clubhouse

Repairs to the sauna and sauna room seats have been undertaken, as well as repainting of lines in the carparks and on the stairs to the lower carpark.

Air-conditioning has been replaced in the members bar and function room.

Continual re-investment in the infrastructure of the club makes the club, and sailing, more accessible to the community. Major investment awaits the completion of the club's Masterplan.

## Club Owned Boats

With the club's busy sailing schedule and regatta program

as well as the Training program, the maintenance of Race Management boats is a high priority.

This year rhib steering systems were replaced, and rhib tubes were repaired.

There was a replacement console for one of the rhibs, and the club keelboat has a replacement mast.

Ongoing repairs and maintenance are undertaken on 12 Optis, 11 Quests and 2 Lasers used for training and racing squads.

## Marina, Hardstand and Yard

Wheelbarrows have been replaced, as well as firehoses on the marina and hardstand. The installation of new wind instruments on the hardstand provides online weather observations to members.

Once again, the club experienced the effects of high tides, which caused no major damage this year, but did require major cleaning up of the hardstand and marina.

## Risk Management and Compliance

The Club's Risk Register and Incident Management process are maintained on an ongoing basis to ensure risks are managed.





MEMBERSHIP REPORT

Membership numbers and splits across membership types have remained fairly stable over the past year, with a light reduction in total membership numbers. Total member numbers as at 30 June 2026 are 1788 compared with 1801 as at 30 June 2025.

Membership is a core pillar of our Strategy and continues to be an important focus of the General Committee. It is important that members of all ages and interests value their membership, and members feel comfortable as part of the RBYC community and proud to be part of it.

New members continue to be welcomed with an interview by a member of General Committee or a senior member of the club.

28.5% of current members are Female which is only slightly higher than last year.

Approximately half of our members are sailing members and the other half a combination of gym, aquatic and social members.

## CRUISING GROUP REPORT

There appears to be a resurgence in interest in the Cruising Group program, which consists principally of the Cruising Group Dinners on the third Friday of each month, and end-of-month on-water activities. In 2026 there has been a steady increase in numbers attending both, which is pleasing to report.

Following the 2026 half-yearly report we enjoyed the following speakers at our monthly dinners:

- Hugh Pilsworth – world circumnavigation.
- Commodore Helen Ward – the fascinating history of Victoria's first battleship, HMAS Cerberus, and early naval action in Victorian waters. Appropriately, Commodore Ward's presentation occurred just before Anzac Day, and the arrival of the new Hunter class naval vessels in Melbourne. It included bringing a scale model of HMS Cerberus.
- Dan Lyons – Crew on Tai Tam for delivery to NZ including a clash with Cyclone Vaianu.
- Brenton and Robina Smith, and Craig Walton – six weeks cruising SA waters in Chakana and Y-Knot.

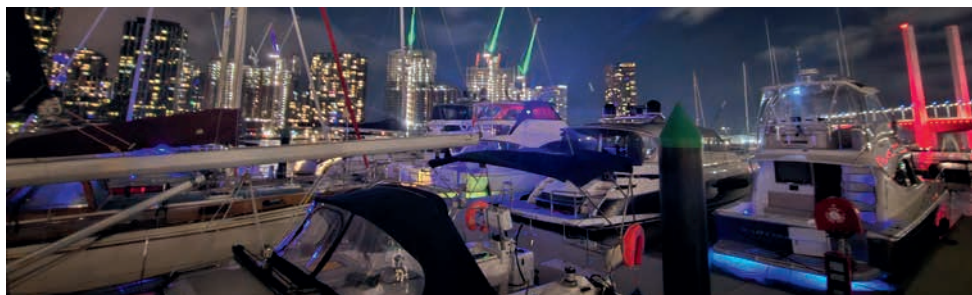

## INCLUSION AND DIVERSITY ADVISORY GROUP

Royal Brighton Yacht Club and Australian Sailing recognise the importance of ensuring that our initiatives and activities are open to all. This requires us to be welcoming, proactive and relevant within a changing environment.

RBYC representatives attended the Australian Sailing Summit, where Inclusion was a major topic. We remind ourselves that as an accredited Australian Sailing Discover Sailing Centre, the club offers opportunities and experiences to suit all abilities. With learn to sail courses, powerboat courses, social sailing, racing and volunteer opportunities, there are several ways to get on the water. As well as Junior and Youth Training, RBYC offers a number of options for adults interested in sailing, whether on dinghies or keelboats. It is encouraging to see many adults who haven't sailed before taking an interest in the sport.

We value our non-boating members, including Aquatic, Gym and Social members, all of whom are closely involved in club activities which makes for a more welcoming and vibrant club.

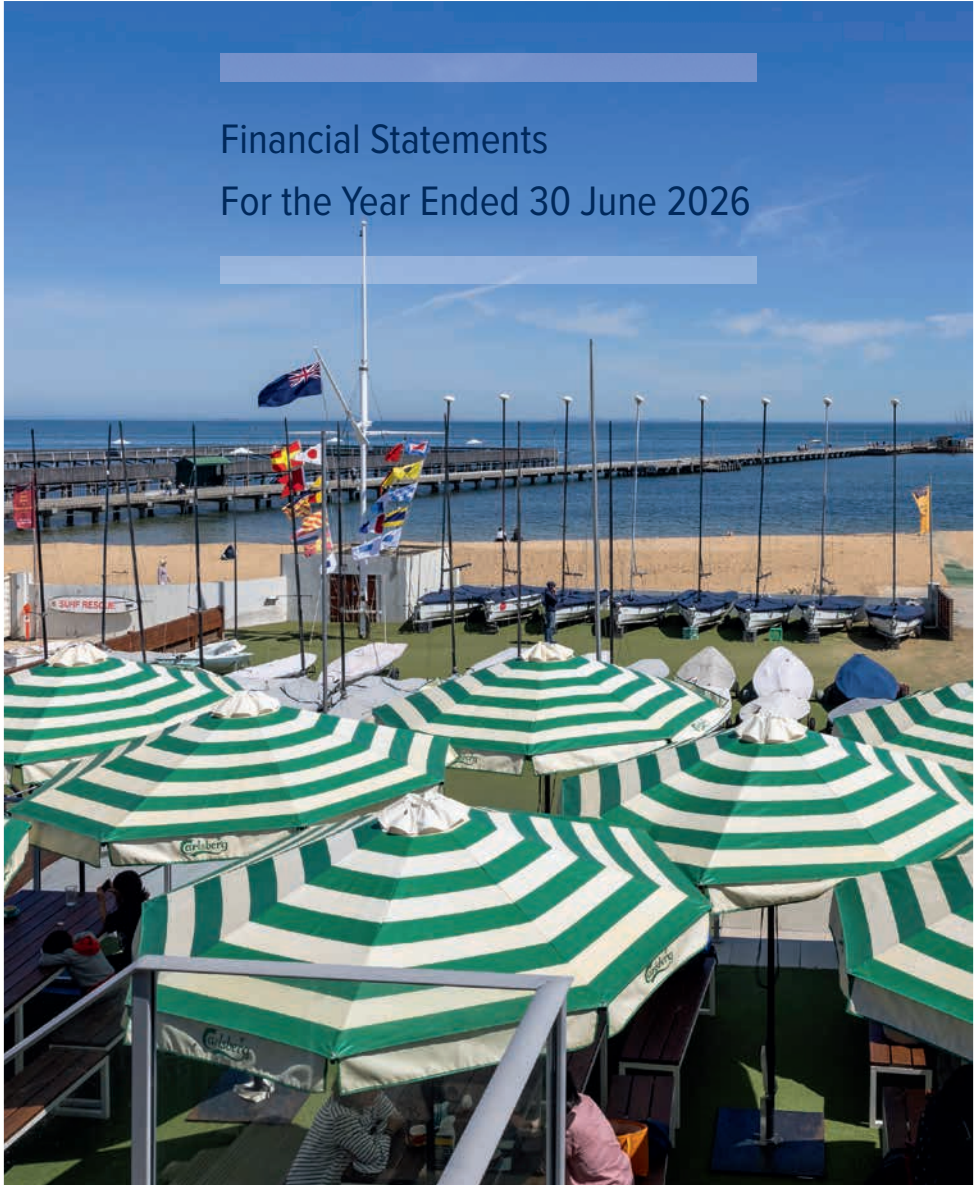

## Honourary

Honorary Treasurer's Report for the year ended 30th June 2026

For the financial year ended 30 June 2026, the audited financial statements report total revenue of \$6.334 million, compared to \$6.652 million in FY25 (down \$317,583, or 4.8%). The Club's FY26 management budget was \$6.495 million; audited revenue was \$160,533, or 2.5%, below budget.

Audited operating surplus before interest, depreciation and amortisation (EBITDA) was \$55,515, compared to a budget of \$240,942 and \$601,944 in FY25. After interest income of \$24,855, finance expenses of \$89,443 and depreciation and amortisation of \$579,634, the audited deficit for FY26 was \$588,707, compared to a \$47,871 deficit in FY25 and a budgeted loss of \$449,658.

## Financial Position and Borrowings

Audited cash and cash equivalents at 30 June 2026 were \$1.038 million, up from \$848,465 at the previous year end, of which a large part relates to pre-paid (FY27) membership and marina subscriptions. Bank borrowings were \$246,740.64, down from \$463,781.20, a reduction of \$217,040.56. Total assets were \$7.313 million, total liabilities were \$3.566 million and net assets were \$3.747 million. Total lease liabilities were \$1.414 million, reflecting the recognition of lease obligations, including the new 21-year Parks Victoria seabed lease covering the marina, hardstand and start tower, which commenced in February 2026.

For FY26, the Club reported EBITDA of \$55,515. With interest income of \$24,855 offsetting finance expenses of \$89,443, net finance costs were \$64,588. After deducting \$217,041 from principal loan repayments, the Club produced a negative cash position of \$226,114 after debt service, demonstrating that the Club's operating income was insufficient to cover interest and principal repayment obligations for the year.

## Hospitality Division Performance

Audited hospitality (bar and hospitality) sales were \$3.202 million, \$142,451 or 4.3% lower than FY25 and \$92,937 or 2.8% below budget. Hospitality cost of goods sold was \$1.141 million, equivalent to 35.6% of sales, an improvement from 36.5% in FY25. The audited financial statements do not separately disclose hospitality wages; the supplementary management divisional analysis continues to identify hospitality labour and full-cost profitability as key areas requiring attention. On the management allocation model, before general overhead allocation, hospitality recorded a negative gross contribution of \$159,505. After allocated overheads of \$412,140, the full-year hospitality result was a loss of \$571,809, approximately \$29,967 worse than budget.

In FY26, members who used their membership fobs to purchase food and beverage spent approximately \$659,482.70, based on the \$65,948.27 value of the 10% member discount. This represents approximately 20.7% of total FY26 revenue of \$3,180,213.64, highlighting members' significant contribution to subsidising F&B for non-members.

## Other Business and Sailing Performance

Membership subscription income was \$1.089 million, up 1.8% on FY25 and 2.3% below budget. Marina, hardstand and boat storage income was \$1.546 million, down 7.7% on FY25 and 8.2% below budget. Sailing income was \$332,802, down 11.6% on FY25 but 19.1% above budget. Donations, grants and sponsorship income increased to \$37,958 from \$10,969 in FY25, mainly due to donations and sponsorship directed towards the Master Plan.

## Summary

The FY26 result reflects softer marina income and continued weakness in hospitality profitability. Total revenue of \$6.334 million was down 4.8% on FY25 and 2.5% below budget, while EBITDA of \$55,515 came in well short of both the

\$240,942 budget and the \$601,944 achieved in FY25. Combined with higher depreciation and finance costs, this produced an audited deficit of \$588,707 for the year.

Marina, hardstand and boat storage income fell 7.7% on FY25 and missed budget by 8.2%, while hospitality remained loss-making despite an improvement in cost of goods sold as a percentage of sales, from 36.5% to 35.6%. These pressures have also constrained the level of maintenance expenditure across the Club's facilities.

There were, however, several positive results. Membership income increased year on year, sailing income exceeded budget by \$53,302, and hospitality cost of goods sold improved as a share of sales.

For FY27, the focus will be on improving hospitality profitability to the point where it can contribute to overheads, recovering marina performance, and preserving sufficient liquidity to meet working capital requirements and future capital and marina commitments.

We appreciate your continued support as we work to strengthen the Club's operating performance and long-term financial position.

The financial statements cover Royal Brighton Yacht Club Inc. as an individual entity. Royal Brighton Yacht Club Inc. is a not-for-profit Association incorporated under the *Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012* ('the Act').

The functional and presentation currency of Royal Brighton Yacht Club Inc. is Australian dollars.

The financial report was authorised for issue by the General Committee on 24 August 2026.

Comparatives are consistent with prior years, unless otherwise stated.

**1 Basis of Preparation**

The financial statements are general purpose financial statements that have been prepared in accordance with the Australian Accounting Standards - Simplified Disclosures and the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs modified, where applicable, by the measurement at fair value of selected non-current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities.

Material accounting policy information relating to the preparation of these financial statements are presented below, and are consistent with prior reporting periods unless otherwise stated.

**2 Material Accounting Policy Information**

**(a) Revenue and other income**

**Revenue from contracts with customers**

Revenue is recognised on a basis that reflects the transfer of control of promised goods or services to customers at an amount that reflects the consideration the Association expects to receive in exchange for those goods or services. Revenue is recognised by applying a five-step model as follows:

1. Identify the contract with the customer
2. Identify the performance obligations
3. Determine the transaction price
4. Allocate the transaction price to the performance obligations
5. Recognise revenue as and when control of the performance obligations is transferred

Generally the timing of the payment for sale of goods and rendering of services corresponds closely to the timing of satisfaction of the performance obligations, however where there is a difference, it will result in the recognition of a receivable, contract asset or contract liability.

**Sale of goods**

Revenue from the sale of food and beverages is recognised at the point of sale, when the economic benefits associated with the transaction flows to the Association and can be reliably measured.

**(a) Revenue and other income**

**Rendering of services**

Revenue from subscriptions, maintenance fees and the lease of marina, hardstand and OTB space is recognised over the period where the customer is entitled to receive benefits from the service provided by the Association. Revenue is recognised when economic benefits are expected to flow to the Association and can be reliably measured.

The Association has numerous long-term leases for Marina space, spanning periods of twelve months or less. Revenue from these leases are defined as operating leases and recognised on a straight-line basis over the agreement terms. All agreements will expire prior to the Association's current lease of the seabed.

**Interest**

Interest is recognised as it accrues using the effective interest method, by calculating the amortised cost of a financial asset and allocating interest over the relevant period. Interest is allocated using the effective rate, which discounts estimated future cash receipts through the expected life of the financial asset to its respective net carrying amount.

**(b) Income Tax**

The Association is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997*.

**(c) Inventories**

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Cost of inventory is determined using the first-in-first-out basis and is net of any rebates and discounts received.

Net realisable value is estimated using the most reliable evidence available at the reporting date and inventory is written down through an obsolescence provision if necessary.

**(d) Property, plant and equipment**

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment.

Items of property, plant and equipment acquired for significantly less than fair value have been recorded at the acquisition date fair value.

**Plant and equipment**

Plant and equipment are measured using the cost model.

**Depreciation**

Property, plant and equipment, excluding freehold land, is depreciated on a straight-line basis over the asset's useful life to the Association, commencing when the asset is ready for use.

**Financial assets**

*Impairment of financial assets*

The Association uses the presumption that a financial asset is in default when:

- the other party is unlikely to pay its credit obligations to the Association in full, without recourse to the Association to actions such as realising security (if any is held); or

*Trade receivables*

Impairment of trade receivables have been determined using the simplified approach in AASB 9 which uses an estimation of lifetime expected credit losses.

The amount of the impairment is recorded in a separate allowance account with the loss being recognised in finance expense. Once the receivable is determined to be uncollectable then the gross carrying amount is written off against the associated allowance.

Where the Association renegotiates the terms of trade receivables due from certain customers, the new expected cash flows are discounted at the original effective interest rate and any resulting difference to the carrying value is recognised in profit or loss.

**Financial liabilities**

The financial liabilities of the Association comprise trade payables, bank and other loans and lease liabilities.

**(f) Leases**

**Lessee accounting**

The non-lease components included in the lease agreement have been separated and are recognised as an expense as incurred.

*Exceptions to lease accounting*

The Association has elected to apply the exceptions to lease accounting for both short-term leases (i.e. leases with a term of less than or equal to 12 months) and leases of low-value assets. The Association recognises the payments associated with these leases as an expense on a straight-line basis over the lease term.

**(g) Going concern**

The Association's activities resulted in a deficit for the year ended 30 June 2026 of \$588,707 (30 June 2025: deficit \$47,871). It has a net current working capital deficit as at 30 June 2026 of \$318,142 (30 June 2025: \$535,184). Encompassed within the total is \$749,373 income for the 2026 year received in advance and current employee entitlements totalling \$415,162 which are not expected to be fully settled in cash within 12 months. When adjusting for these items, the adjusted working capital is \$846,393.

The financial statements have been prepared on the basis that the Association is a going concern which contemplates the continuity of normal business activity, realisation of assets and settlement of liabilities in the normal course of business for the following reasons:

At 30 June 2026 the Association had net assets of \$3,746,545, cash reserves of \$1,038,374 and generated net cash inflows from operating activities of \$558,877.

The General Committee believe that the Association will continue to successfully manage the operations of the entity and accordingly, they have prepared the financial report on a going concern basis. At this time the General Committee are of the opinion that no asset is likely to be realised for an amount less the amount at which is recorded in the financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2026.

**(h) Adoption of new and revised accounting standards**

The Association has adopted all standards which became effective for the first time at 30 June 2026, the adoption of these standards has not caused any material adjustments to the reported financial position, performance or cash flow of the Association.

**3 Critical Accounting Estimates and Judgments**

The General Committee make estimates and judgements during the preparation of these financial statements regarding assumptions about current and future events affecting transactions and balances.

These estimates and judgements are based on the best information available at the time of preparing the financial statements, however as additional information is known then the actual results may differ from the estimates.

The significant estimates and judgements made have been described below.

**Key estimates - impairment of property, plant and equipment**

The Association assesses impairment at the end of each reporting period by evaluating conditions specific to the Association that may be indicative of impairment triggers. Recoverable amounts of relevant assets are reassessed using value-in-use calculations which incorporate various key assumptions.

**Key estimates - estimation of useful lives of assets**

The Association determines the estimated useful lives and related depreciation and amortisation charges for its property, plant and equipment and finite life intangible assets. The useful lives could change significantly as a result of technical innovations or some other event. The depreciation and amortisation charge will increase where the useful lives are less than previously estimated lives, or technically obsolete or non-strategic assets that have been abandoned or sold will be written off or written down.

**Key estimates - receivables**

The receivables at reporting date have been reviewed to determine whether there is any objective evidence that any of the receivables are impaired. An impairment provision is included for any receivable where the entire balance is not considered collectible. The impairment provision is based on the best information at the reporting date.

Committee members monitor interest rate risk by being aware of market forecasts for interest rates. Ageing analyses and monitoring of specific credit allowances are undertaken to manage credit risk, liquidity risk is monitored through general business budgets and forecasts.

**Credit risk**

Credit risk refers to the risk that a counterparty will default on its contractual obligations resulting in a financial loss to the Association.

Credit risk arises from cash and cash equivalents and deposits with banks and financial institutions, as well as credit exposure to wholesale and retail customers, including outstanding receivables and committed transactions.

The maximum exposure to credit risk, excluding the value of any collateral or other security, at Reporting Date to recognised financial assets is the carrying amount of those assets, net of any allowance for doubtful debts, as disclosed in the Statement of Financial Position and notes to the financial report.

The Association trades primarily with Association members and other creditworthy third parties, as such collateral is not requested nor is the Club's policy to securitise its trade and other receivables.

Receivables balances are monitored on an ongoing basis with the result that the Association's exposure to bad debts is not significant. There are no significant concentrations on credit risk.
